SCOPE OF WORK

Services -

Approximately 1 mlle on Cherokee WMA

Located in Cherokee County

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Description of work:

Existing fireguards need renovated from encroaching timber. With the use of a dozer and excavator to clear the timber, the fireguard wi-11 be operational for use in the future. The fireguard is along the roadsides and will cleared back 30 feet on each side by dozer and excavator. The timber will be pushed in wind rows along the roadsides. The finished product will be to clear fireguards of all timber and brush along 1 mile of existing roads 30 feet on each side which is approximately 8 acres.

Work to begin any time as feasible upon notice to proceed .t

All work must be completed by no later than March 31, 2025

Project needs to be completed during the tirne frame of upon notice to proceed.through March 31, 2025 to accommodate the Biological Opinion for Northern Long-eared Bat restrictions

Vendor is to provide all labor and needed equipment to complete the work as required. Project must be completed in eighty (80) days of contract award. All work will be done as directed by the ODWC Area Biologist.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor only.:If vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project as required by contract documents.

<u>Insurance:</u> The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles and worker compensation along with bonds listed in the project manual general conditions immediately upon notification that they are the successful bidder. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

<u>Basis of Contract:</u> The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest extended price. (acres or liner feet price)

The owner reserves the right to make any inquires to insure that the lowest bidder is actually able to complete the work in a satisfactory manner.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, Construction and Properties Division (OMES/CAP). The Contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by OMES/CAP.

Minimum Equipment Requirements:

The dozer must be at least a DS with a minimum of 100 horsepower with operating weight of 22,000 lbs and equipped with a six-way blade. Dozer must also be equipped with rippers. Excavator must be a minimum of 100 horsepower with operating weight of 37,000 lbs.
