## SCOPE OF WORK

## Services – Vegetation Removal

Approximately 190 Acres eastern red cedar removal of Cooper Wildlife Management Area (WMA) Located in Woodward County, Oklahoma

## 1. General Requirements:

The proposed contract is selective removal of eastern red cedar through mastication or mechanical cutting and stacking to reduce volatile fuel loads and improve wildlife habitat on 190 acres located on the Fort Supply Wildlife Management Area in Woodward County. See attached map for the project area.

- Cedars must be cut at ground level and no green branches can remain on the tree stump.
- Cut and stack Eastern Red Cedars—Cut and stack all cedar trees within a 75 ft. radius cut from mature hardwood roost trees. Roost trees are not to be damaged during the cedar removal process.
- Mastication is permitted in the place of cutting and stacking as long as masticated material is evenly distributed and does not average more than 6 inches in depth on the ground.
- Cutting of Eastern Red Cedar—All eastern red cedar trees <u>not</u> located within a 75 ft. radius of roost trees can be cut and left where they fall. All visible cedar trees are to be cut.
- Cut cedars must be stacked at least 100 feet from all roads, fences, and powelines.
- Hand cutting of Eastern Red Cedar Hand cutting of cedar trees may be required around roost trees to prevent machinery damage to the tree.
- Minimum Equipment Requirements—Cutting and mulching equipment must have a minimum of 100 horsepower. All equipment used must be low ground pressure and equipped with rubber tracks or rubber tires.
- Some cedars are large and will be difficult to cut. Some cedars are located on sandy, steep terrain. The successful bidder must have the proper equipment to cut these cedars.

Vendor is to provide all needed equipment to complete the work as required. All work will be done as directed by the ODWC Area Biologist.

## **Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting Requirement:**

Please note: An onsite mandatory pre-bid meeting will be required for this project.

The Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will begin on February 4<sup>th</sup> 2025 at 10:00 AM and will be held at the following location:

No work can be done on site from April 12-22,2025 during spring turkey season.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor. If vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project as required by contract documents.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, Construction and Properties Division (OMES/CAP). The Contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by OMES/CAP.

Bids are invited as stated on the solicitation cover sheet and must be returned by the date and time specified. Late bids will not be considered. All bids must be accompanied by the Affidavit, attached.

<u>Insurance</u>: The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles and worker compensation in the amounts specified in the contract (attached) immediately upon notification that they are the successful bidder. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

Basis of Contract: The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest per acre rate, along with proposed time to complete the work. Failure to submit a complete bid, inclusive of affidavits and requested information, may disqualify the bidder. ODWC reserves the right to make any inquiries to insure that the lowest bidder is actually able to complete the work in a satisfactory manner.

Terms and conditions: As stated in the contract.

<u>Change Orders</u>: Changes in the work shall not be undertaken without prior written authorization. Field personnel are not authorized to modify the scope of work in any way or to issue change orders to this contract. Contractor shall submit a written request for a proposed change, the reason for the proposed change and the increase or decrease in price and time required as a result of the change. Cumulative changes that exceed the original contract price by more than 15% are prohibited by Oklahoma law.


<u>Travel</u>: Operator <u>will not</u> be compensated for travel to and from work sites.
