The issuance of this Solicitation does not guarantee that the State of Oklahoma will enter into an agreement, and the State reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

SCOPE OF WORK

Forest Mulching Services

Approximately 82 acres on Lexington WMA

Located in Cleveland County

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Description of work

Enhance turkey roost habitat along the Little Buckhead Creek riparian zone located on Lexington WMA in Cleveland County. Within this riparian zone, operators will be required to remove ALL cedars (any size) and ALL other tree species with a diameter at breast height (DBH) of 10 inches or less (except any smaller trees marked with flagging will remain standing) through mastication to improve roost habitat on Lexington WMA. Special emphasis will be placed on targeted turkey roost tree sites.

- 1. The Riparian Zone is broken into four mulching sites (see attached maps). Each site or polygons represents a line on the solicitation. The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation will award the lines on the purchase order based on the available funding.
- 2. Within each of the four sites, operators will remove ALL Cedars and ALL other tree species with DBH of 10 inches or less to ground level (excluding smaller trees marked with flagging). Tree trunks between 6 and 10 inches DBH may be felled with limbs removed instead of mulched. Other than this provision, no masticated piece of wood may remain larger than 10 pounds weight.
- 3. Located within each of the four sites are orange pen points. These orange points represent potential turkey roost trees or clusters of roost trees. At these points, ALL trees within a 100 ft radius of the roost tree with a DBH of 15 inches or less must be removed by mastication. Tree trunks between 6 and 15 inches are not required to be mulched, but must have all limbs removed and must be removed from the 100 ft radius around the roost trees. Targeted roost tree sites will be marked with flagging tape for the NON-mandatory vendor pre-bid meeting that will be held on February 12th, 2025, to begin at 1:00PM Central Standard Time.
- 4. Minimum Equipment Requirements --Vendor is to provide all equipment needed to complete the work as required. All equipment must be equipped with rubber tracks or rubber tires.
- -Operator will not be allowed to work from April 11 30, 2025 due to peak usage periods during hunting season, but can leave equipment on site if desired.

-At completion of work, an agency representative will conduct a final inspection with the operator. Operator must complete any corrective work as directed.

Note: ODWC plans to conduct a prescribed burn in this area on a day between February and April when weather conditions are suitable. This burn would shut down work for one day, and could make work difficult until the first rain settled the ashes. Since ODWC has an active burning program on the WMA, equipment should be parked in food plots or other locations where they would not burn up in a wildfire.

All work must be completed by 90 days of contract award. The restricted dates in April do not count towards the 90 days available for project completion. Work should begin by April 1, 2025 upon contract award.


Vendor is to provide all labor and needed equipment to complete the work as required. Project must be completed in ninety (90) days of contract award. All work will be done as directed by the ODWC Area Biologist.

Basis of Contract: The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest per acre rate, along with proposed time to complete the work. ODWC reserves the right to make any inquiries to insure that the lowest bidder is actually able to complete the work in a satisfactory manner.


14111 Slaughterville Rd. Lexington, OK. 73071

Turn east off highway 77 in Slaughterville, OK. onto Slaughterville Rd. Proceed approx. 6 miles and you will see the brown Lexington WMA sign on the South side of the road. Area biologist will show you to the exact location due to there being gated roads.

Site location: 5 mi East of Slaughterville, OK. Located on the Lexington WMA between Duffy and York Road, between 144th and 156th streets along Little Buckhead creek.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor only. If vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project as required by contract documents.

<u>Insurance</u>: The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles and worker compensation listed in the project general conditions immediately upon notification that they are the successful bidder. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

Failure to submit a complete bid, inclusive of affidavits and requested information, may disqualify the bidder. ODWC reserves the right to make any inquires to insure that the lowest bidder is actually able to complete the work in a satisfactory manner.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, Construction and Properties Division (OMES/CAP). The Contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by OMES/CAP.

<u>Terms and conditions:</u> As stated in the contract.

<u>Invoicing and Project Communication:</u> All work-execution related communications must go through the Agency Representative. Project invoices, Affidavit for Payment, shall be sent to the Agency Representative at the following address and attention:

2. EXECUTION

<u>Scheduling:</u> Provide Agency Representative with proposed work schedule prior to beginning work.

Travel: Operator(s) will not be compensated for travel to and from sites.

<u>Closeout</u>: At completion of the work, conduct final inspection with Agency Representative. Complete any corrective work as directed.

<u>Change Orders:</u> Changes in the work shall not be undertaken without prior written authorization. Field personnel are not authorized to modify the scope of work in any way or to issue change orders to this contract. Contractor shall submit a written request for a proposed change, the reason for the proposed change and the increase or decrease in price and time required as a result of the change. Cumulative changes that exceed the original contract price by more than 15% are prohibited by Oklahoma law.
