

# Scope Of Work

# Services - Vegetation/Brush Clearing On one location on the Kaw Lake Wildlife Management Area (WMA) Located in Kay County, Oklahoma

#### 1. General Requirements:

Project Goal: Reduce woody vegetation by mulching brush and trees smaller than 10 inches in diameter and removing all Eastern Red Cedars. The thinning work will be done at the direction of the Area Biologist. All work is to be completed on Kaw WMA. Scheduling contractor will provide agency representative with proposed work schedule prior to beginning. Operator will not be compensated for travel time to and from the work site. At completion of the work, conduct final inspection with agency representative.

Operator has 90 days to complete work upon starting and ALL work is to be completed by June 15, 2026. Work cannot be conducted between April 15, 2026 and May 15, 2026.

Larger trees (diameter greater than 6 inches) can be felled and all limbs removed to improve efficiency. Other than this provision no other single piece of woody debris should be larger than 5lbs. Stumps should be cut to a height of 6 inches or less.

Vendor must supply all labor and equipment to complete the project. Any equipment used must have rubber wheels/tracks; metal tracked equipment cannot be used.

All work will be coordinated with by the ODWC Area Biologist.

Estimated project size is 43 acres.

Interested vendors must attend a <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid meeting, Tuesday, November 18, 2025, 10:30 AM CST.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor only. If the vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project simultaneously.

Insurance: The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles, and worker compensation immediately upon notification that they are the successful bidder. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

Basis of Contract: The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest extended price (number of acres X price per acre).

The Owner reserves the right to make any inquiries to ensure that the lowest bidder can complete the work in a satisfactory manner.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Service, Construction and

Properties Division (DCAM/CAP). The Contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by DCAM/CAP.

Terms and Conditions: As stated in the contract.
