## **SCOPE OF WORK**

## Services – Tree/Vegetation/Brush Mulching

Waurika Wildlife Management Area (WMA)

Up to 44 acres of selective woody vegetation removal

Located in Cotton County, Oklahoma

#### 1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The proposed contract is for the selective removal of heavy brush and timber within a designated area through mechanical cutting and mastication to remove thick, overgrown encroaching woody vegetation, to allow for prescribed burning, and to improve turkey roost sites and wildlife habitat. Proposed contract will require removal and mastication/mulching of all trees and brush 8 inches and less in diameter within designated blocks on WMA. Trees and brush to be masticated will include, but are not limited to: Oak, Elm, Pecan, Willow, Cottonwood, Ash, Boxelder, Eastern Red Cedar, Black Locust, Honey Locust, Hackberry, Plum thickets, Sumac thickets, green briar, etc. All masticated material should be adequately mulched and average no more than 6 inches in depth on the ground. All trunks will be cut as close as possible to the ground, but not below soil surface.

The project will include up to 44 acres in selected areas across Waurika WMA.

Project area is located South of Highway 53, 1 mile East of N2700 Rd. in Cotton County OK.

<u>Minimum equipment requirements</u>: All equipment must be rubber tracked or have rubber wheels/tires.

Operator will not be compensated for maintenance and repair of equipment.

The project will take place on various locations on Waurika Wildlife Management Area. Additional directions and maps will be given to winning bidder upon contact award.

Vendor is to provide all labor and needed equipment to complete the work as required. Project must be completed within ninety (90) days of contract award/notice to proceed. All work will be done as directed by the area Biologist.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor only. If vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project as required by contract documents.

<u>Insurance</u>: The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles and worker compensation along with bonds listed in the project manual general conditions immediately upon notification that they are the successful bidder. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

<u>Basis of Contract</u>: The determination of the lowest responsible bidder will be made based on the lowest price per acre. (price per acre x 44 ac. = total cost).

ODWC reserves the right to make any inquires to insure that the lowest bidder is actually able to complete the work satisfactorily.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, Construction and Properties Division (OMES/CAP). The contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by OMES/CAP.

Terms and Conditions: As stated in the contract.
