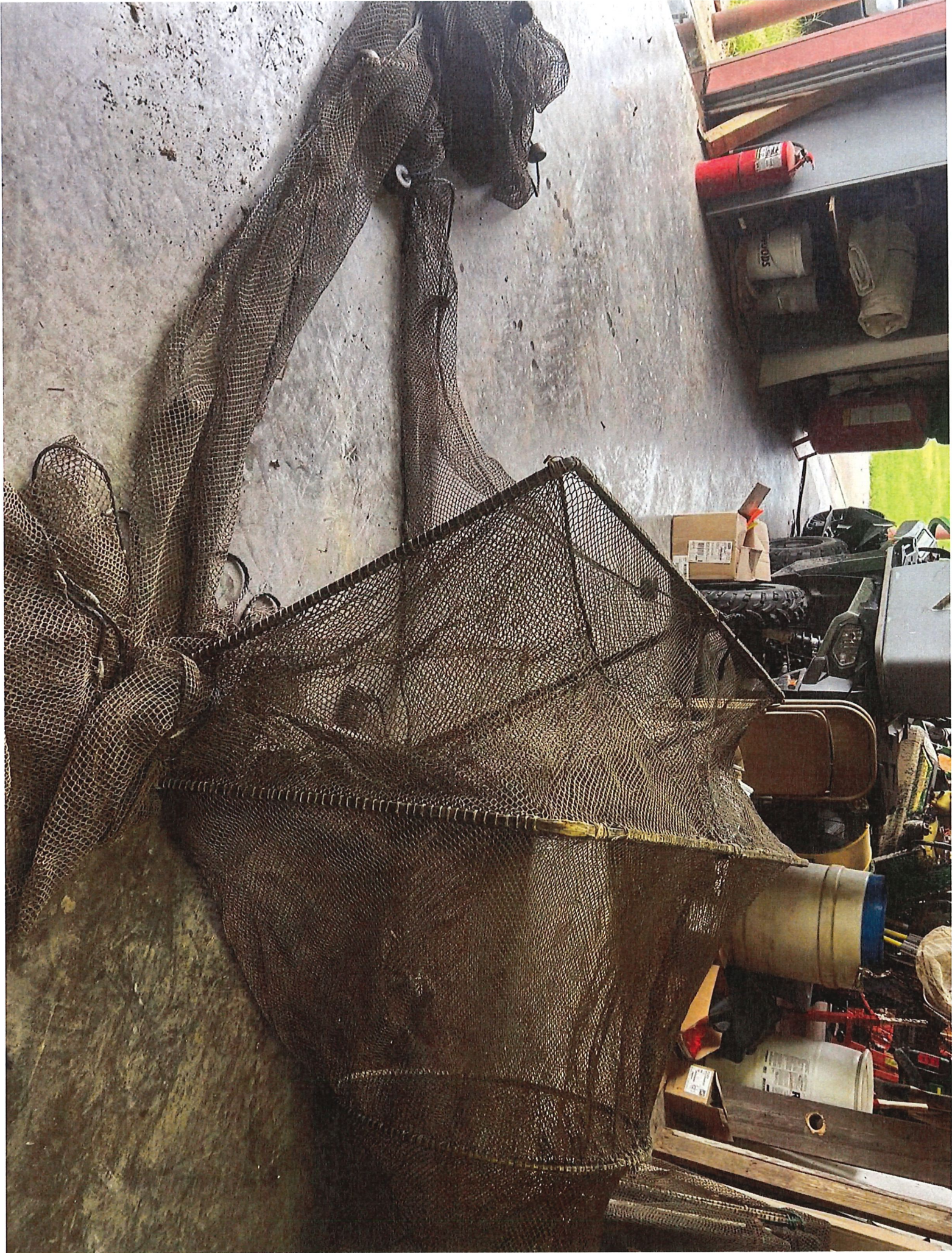

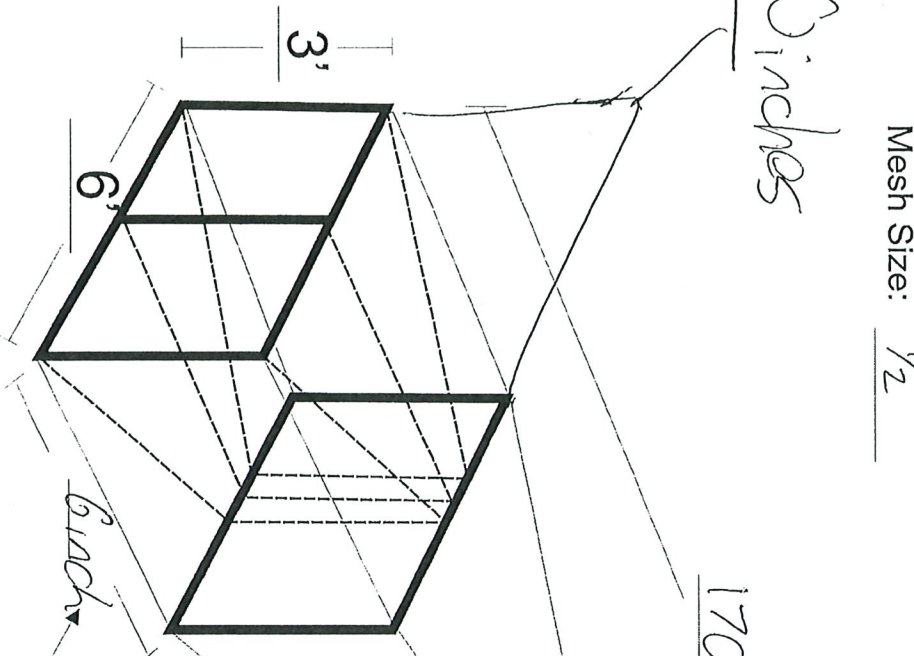






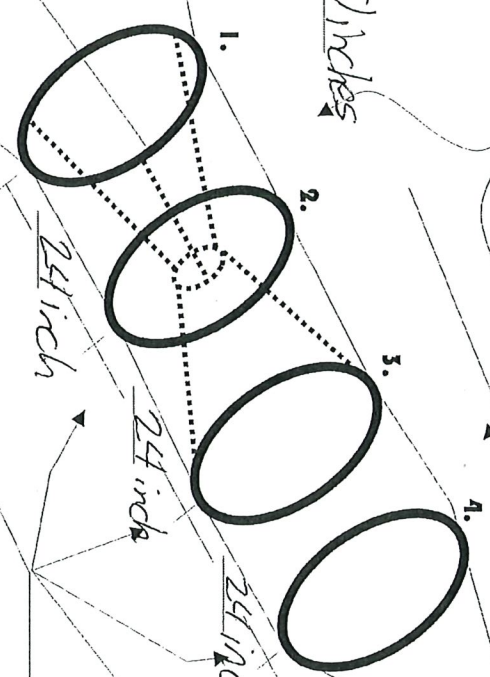

Question: What is the award date?

Amendment No 2 Continued

Question: is the Oct 08th delivery a firm date or is it flexible.

Answer: Date is somewhat flexible but if vendor can not meet that date we need to know when to expect nets. Later dates may result in ODWC not having the nets for sampling season and thus opting to choose a different vendor.

Question: Distance between Frame 1 and Frame 2.

Question: What is the net treated with, is there a specific coating? And this states it should be coated after the assembly is that correct?

Answer: The netting should be coated to enhance longevity of the netting. It can be treated whenever the vendor typically treats netting in their process. Some vendors use a tar coating others use an ecoresin.

Question: #105 twine, do you mean #15? Also, what is the netting mesh size and color?

Answer: Our specifications do say #105 -L knotless nylon. I do not know what #15 is or how it compares. The mesh size is 13 mm. ½ mesh will also suffice. Color is not important as long as it is a darker color or is dark in color once coated. We prefer a dark or black color if that is an option.

Question: What is the full length from cod end to end of wings?

Answer: [See Drawing included in this Amendment.](#) From front of trap to cod closure is 170 inches. There are no wings.

Question: Do you have any specs of the construction of the netting assemblies considering the variety of fyke nets?

Answer: I am not sure what you are asking here. The netting assemblies should be taut when stretched out, and 13 mm or ½ inch mesh.

Question: How much excess netting between hoops to create throats, in example would 5' hoops spacing requires 7' length of net?

Answer: 2, See Drawing included in this Amendment.

Question: I see specs for a lead at 65.5', but does this assembly have 2 wings as well, and what are the dimensions?

Answer: There are no wings.
