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The proposed contract is for removal of approximately 139 acres of select woody vegetation to renovate fireguards and cut Eastern Red Cedar trees in various locations on the Fort Supply WMA.

Fireguard renovation will include approximately 56 acres of mastication/mulching to remove all Eastern Red Cedar trees, regardless of size, and all other woody vegetation up to 24 inches in diameter. All mulching must be completed as near to ground level as the terrain will allow but not below the soil surface. All masticated material will average no more than 6 inches in depth and be no greater than 24 inches in length. Upon completion of the project, all mulched debris needs to be flat and at ground level so as to be easily maintainable with a brush hog mover.

Selected treatment removal will include approximately 83 acres of Eastern Red Cedar removal. Eastern Red Cedars trees must be cut as close to ground level as possible but not below the soil surface. All trees cut in the selected treatment area can be left where they fall.

Minimum Equipment Requirement: All equipment used must be low ground pressure and equipped with rubber tires or tracks.

Work to be done on approximately 139 acres in selected areas across the Fort Supply Wildlife Management Area. Fort Supply WMA is located approximately one mile south of the town of Fort Supply in Woodward County.

Vendor will be responsible for supplying all needed materials, equipment, tools and labor to complete the work as required.

Timing: Work will not be permitted to begin prior to January 15, 2021. Project must be completed by June 1, 2021. All location and work dates will be coordinated with area biologist. All work will be done as directed by the ODWC area biologist.

Basis of Contract: The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest extended price (per acre rate x 139 acres). All hand crew work needed should be figured into the per acre rate for the project.

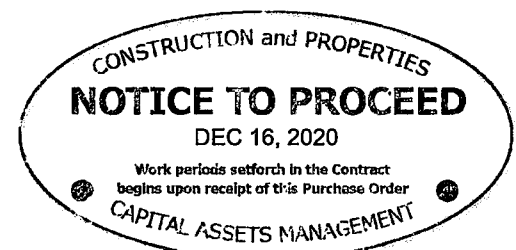
#### EXECUTION
