Scope of Work

Services – Mowing/Brush Hog & Disking/Planting Wheat

Copan Wildlife Management Area (WMA), Washington County, Oklahoma

1. General Requirements

The proposed contract is for mowing of approximately 18 miles of roads and 5 miles of dikes. Disking habitat plots and planting wheat on approximately 28 acres. Mowing/brush hogging will need to be done three times. **First mowing time**, the week of August 1, 2025, second mowing time week of September 23, 2025, and third mowing time June 9, 2026.

In addition, mowing habitat plots once in august and disking two times and planting wheat on time on approximately 28 acres on Copan WMA. Mowing on habitat plots can begin August 15, 2025, disking twice and planting can start September 9, 2025. The disking and planting can be done on the same day. Wheat must be certified clean wheat and planted at a rate of 90 pounds per acre.

Mowing/brush hogging and disking/planting wheat will be done on the Copan Wildlife Management Area in Washington County in northeast Oklahoma (see attached map). Additional directions will be given to the awarded vendor as needed.

Minimum Equipment Requirement: The equipment to be used must meet the following minimum specifications: The mower/brush hog must have a minimum width of 15 feet.

Vendor is to provide all labor and needed equipment to complete the work as required. The operator will not be compensated for the time spent on maintenance and repairs of equipment. All work will be done as directed by the ODWC Area Biologist including dates and start time.

Contract will be awarded to one vendor only. If the vendor is awarded multiple ODWC projects, they must be capable of completing each project simultaneously.

Bids are invited as stated on the solicitation cover sheet and must be returned by date and time specified. Late bids will not be considered.

<u>Insurance:</u> The successful bidder will be required to provide certificates of insurance for general liability, vehicles, and work compensation. A contract will not be issued without the required proof of insurance.

Basis of Contract: The proposed contract will be a lump sum contract. The determination of the Lowest Responsible Bidder will be made based on the lowest extended price. Failure to submit a complete bid, inclusive of requested information may disqualify the bidder. ODWC reserves the right to make any inquiries to ensure that the lowest bidder can complete the work in a satisfactory manner.

The contract will be issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, Construction and Properties Division (OMES/CAP). The contractor shall not begin work until the contract is in place and written notice to proceed has been issued by OMES/CAP.

<u>Terms and Conditions:</u> As stated in the contract.
