

Q1 How likely is it that you would recommend Rack Madness to others?



Q2 How organized was Rack Madness?





Q3 How friendly was the staff at Rack Madness?





Q4 How helpful was the staff at Rack Madness?





Q5 How satisfied were you with your wait time to get scored at Rack Madness?




