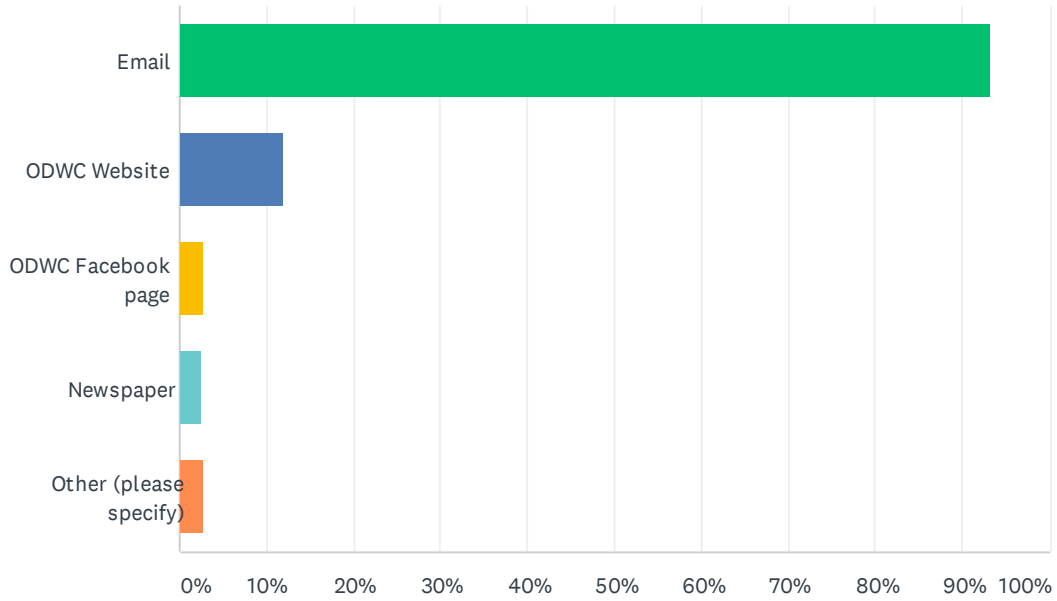

## Q1 Where do you typically read the fishing report? Check all that apply.

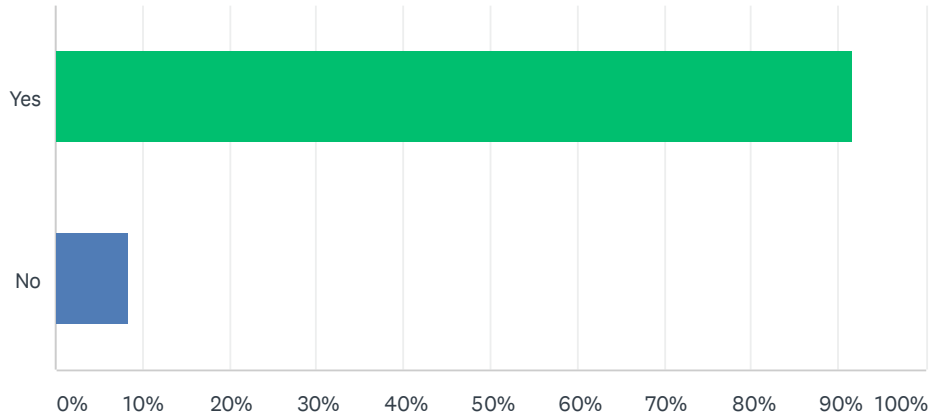

## Q2 Are you satisfied with the way(s) in which you read the fishing report?

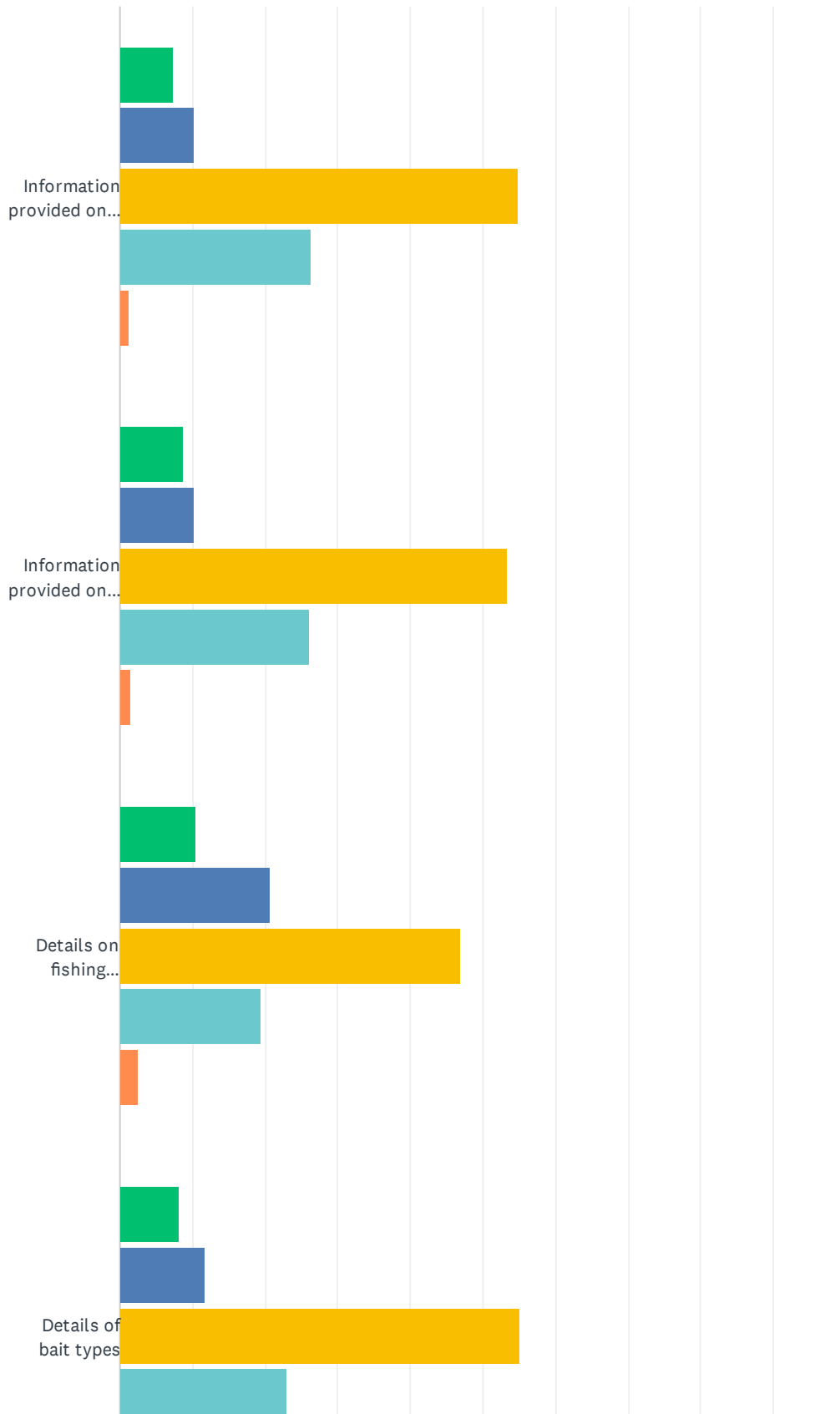

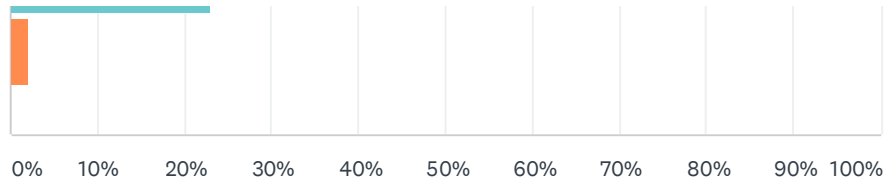

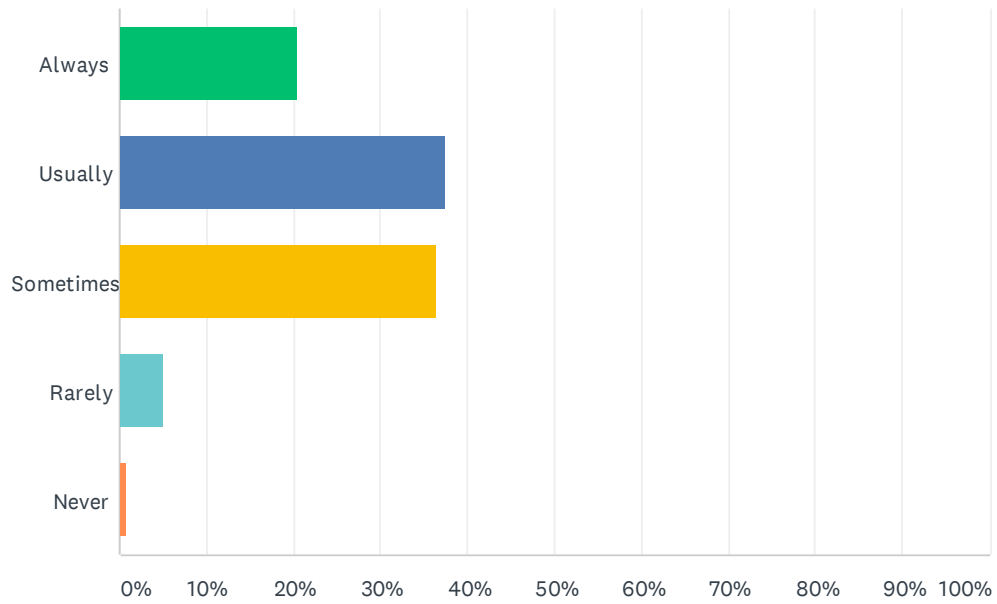

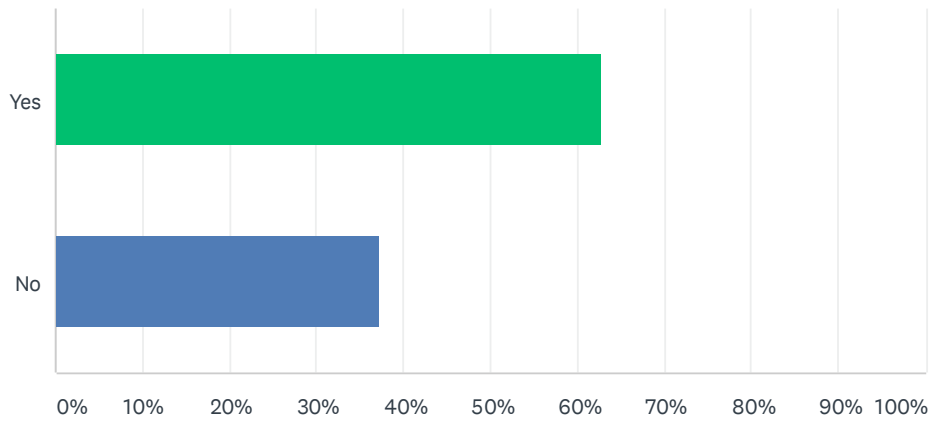

### Q5 Is there enough information in the fishing report to prepare you for your fishing trips?

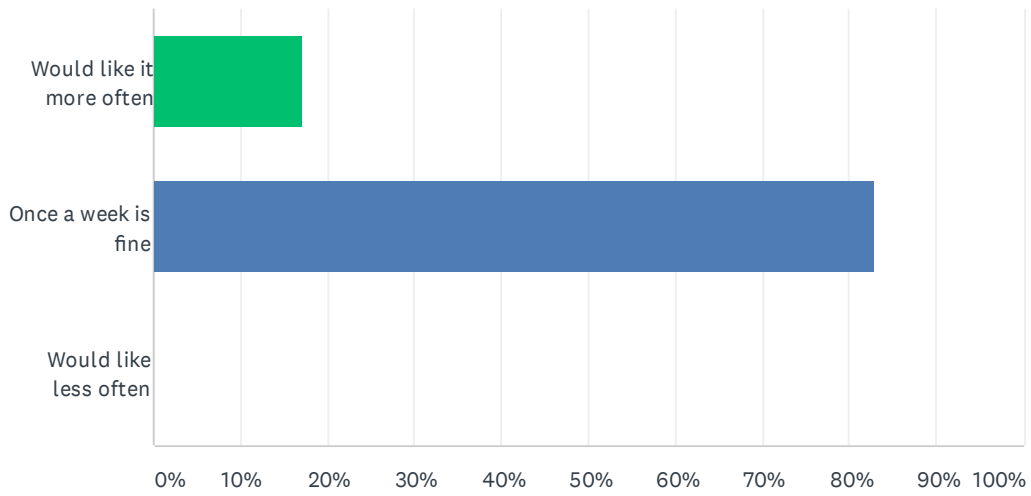
