Sooner Lake Duck Hunting Map & Regs

OPEN AREAS

Only waterfowl hunting by permit is allowed. Waterfowl hunters must hunt within 50 yards of staked, numbered blind sites. Numbered blind sites are designated on Sooner Lake hunt map. All other areas of the lake are closed to hunting.

DAYS OPEN FOR HUNTING

Sooner Lake is open for waterfowl hunting <u>only on Tuesdays</u>, <u>Thursdays</u>, <u>Saturdays</u>, <u>and Sundays</u> during all waterfowl seasons. Consult hunting regulations for season dates.

HUNTING HOURS

One-half hour before legal sunrise to legal sunset

SPECIES WHICH MAY BE HUNTED

Ducks, coots, and geese. Consult hunting regulations for bag limits and restrictions

LEGAL MEANS OF TAKE

Shotgun using federally approved nontoxic shot.

WATERFOWL HUNTING BLIND SITES

Hunting blind sites are designated on the Sooner Lake Waterfowl Hunting Map. All blind sites are staked with a reflective top t-post. Hunters must be within 50 yards of the staked blind marker. Temporary blinds only and they must be removed at eth end of each hunt. A camouflaged boat is considered a temporary blind site. No vegetation on Sooner Lake property may be cut for construction of blinds.

VEHICLES AND BOATS

All vehicles must be parked in one of the four designated parking areas (see map). Boats may be used to travel to staked blind sites.

HUNTER CHECK STATION

Hunters must obtain permit prior to hunting from the self-service check station located at the east boat ramp off State Highway 15. See Hunter Check Station Procedures.

Hunters failing to follow check station procedures or who violate and Sooner Lake waterfowl hunting regulation may be denied a permit to hunt Sooner Lake the remainder of the waterfowl season (800:25-5-98)
